Residential Conservation Incentive
<p>As a conservation incentive, Tier 2 residential users that reduce usage in any month by at least ten percent (10%) below such user’s previous four year history (as such history was determined for the purpose of assigning the user to a tier) shall be billed at the Tier 1 rate. In the event this ten percent (10%) monthly conservation goal is not met, any usage over the Tier 1 limit will be billed at the Tier 2 rate.</p> <p>The goal for the first four year period following implementation of the Tiered Rates (the first “Management Period”) shall be an average reduction of fifteen percent (15%) in per dwelling unit usage. In the event this objective is not met, the District’s Conservation Committee shall propose additional measures to achieve the desired level of conservation. Such measures may include, but are not necessarily limited to, inclusion of an additional tier, increased rates for higher tiers, or other measures as deemed appropriate.</p> <p>At least once during each Management Period (following the first Management Period) the District shall develop an additional conservation incentive for the purpose of achieving the conservation goal as set by the District’s Board of Directors upon the advice and recommendation of the District’s Conservation Committee. The District may engage the services of consultants, if necessary, in order to develop such additional incentives.</p>

¹ Tier 1 rates are the same as the existing rate in each Improvement District.

² One Unit equals 748 gallons of water.
