The intent of Staff is to make a recommendation for the selected Contractor and request a Notice to Proceed at the February 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting.
- B. **BWD Website:** Creation of a new website is underway with the help of local Borrego HS student Greyson Levens.
- C. **2018 Water Bond:** Following the January BWD Board Meeting, I informed Dr Gerald Meral that BWD approved up to \$40,000 to be used for polling on the proposed 2018 Water Bond, if needed. Dr Meral thanked us for the offer and informed the state-wide stakeholder group of our action. As of now, there has not been a request for the funds.

#### Dear Mike and Members:

If the BWC wishes to continue having two Borrego Water District (BWD) representatives attending the BWC meetings open or closed we have been advised of some potential problematic issues. We have two BWD Board members at the BWD GSA public meetings with GSA of San Diego County and two BWD Board members possibly on the BWC. Per the Brown Act we cannot communicate amongst ourselves discussions leading to decisions by the BWD board or the GSA's. If BWC discussions only relates to procedural issues, time lines, etc. We don't see that as "making a decision" by our involvement, nor do we see that as "leading to a decision" of the board of the BWD. However, if the discussion is leading to a vote and relates to actions that the BWD may take, we need to stop the discussion and the two of us leave the room. The minutes shall indicate we left the room and did not vote. The other Coalition representatives, without the two of us, can continue their discussion and decide whether there is a desire to approach the BWD/GSA board in an open meeting, to discuss.

That said, we will try to bring this up at the beginning of a BWC discussion, and let everybody know that we cannot participate if the discussion is leading to a vote that potentially leads to a GSA agenda item and vote.
